



Batting 1.000 Seminoles Players Code of Conduct

*****I UNDERSTAND THAT IF I DO NOT FOLLOW ANY OF THE RULES DETAILED BELOW, I WILL BE SAT AT THE TIME OF THE INCIDENT IF DURING GAME AND SERVE A ONE GAME SUSPENSION.**

- I will refrain from unsportsmanlike gestures, talk, language, or cursing.
- I will not taunt or tease opposing players.
- I will show respect towards the umpires and their decisions. All decisions made by the umpires are to be accepted as final. I will not argue a call or judgment. If I have a problem with the umpire's call, I will talk to a coach. Only the Manager and Coach should be questioning calls and judgments.
- I will not throw my bat, helmet, glove, or any object in disgust on or off the playing field at any time.
- I will not miss practice unless there is a legitimate excuse. IE: sick or school related. If I do have to miss practice a phone call will be made one hour prior to practice to the coach by me, not my parents.
- Although coaches will do their best with playing time, I will accept the coach's decision regarding playing positions and the amount of playing time. I understand that this is a Travel Team and there are no guarantees for equal playing time or position. If I have a question, I will agree to talk to the coach like a gentlemen **after** the game without the presence of other players.
- I understand that the coaches reserve the right to suspend or sit any player from the team for poor sportsmanship during games. Other reasons I can be suspended or sat for are, lack of cooperation, poor attitude, lack of commitment, effort, or attendance.
- I understand that the Coaches may impose additional rules, guidelines and/or policies that I am required to follow and failure to comply with the rules, guidelines and/or policies is a violation of my commitment and I could face a suspension.
- I will not barrel the catcher at home plate as it is an automatic expulsion from the league.
- I am committed to the Batting 1.000 Seminoles for the duration of the team's season, from the beginning of winter workouts to the end of the summer season. I am allowed to play baseball for other teams, but it is not to effect this team - practice OR games. If I am going to miss a game because of another baseball game I will be suspended the following game. If I am going to be a late for a Seminoles game because of playing for another team, I will not play that game. If I am going to be late for a game for any other reason, I will call with plenty of notice so the coaches can plan ahead. Same goes for planned vacations. School and school sports are not included and take preference over and above all, but I will inform my coach.
- Grades MUST be passing!! If I am failing, I will discuss with the coach and my parents.
- Dress Code - I will always bring all uniforms to games. I will wear Seminole issued apparel for all practices and games. I will always have my shirt tucked in when wearing baseball pants. I will ALWAYS wear a belt when wearing baseball pants. My Seminoles hat will never be worn backwards on or off the field.
- I will not leave the practice field or dugout in a game until they are completely cleaned up and maintained following coach's orders.
- I will not look at my cell phone at all during games or practices.
- I will demonstrate 100% A.C.E (Attitude, Effort and Concentration) at all times while playing in games and practicing.
- Parents and Athletes will be fully liable for damages to hotels, vehicles, and any personal property or general behavior occurred while playing for the Seminoles.
- Any player found to be using any alcohol or illegal substance will be released from the organization with no refund
- All fees are non-refundable unless special circumstances are determined by ownership
- **I WILL BE A GOOD TEAMMATE!!!**

****Suspensions must be carried out by being at practices and the suspended game or games. I must be in full practice and game uniform during suspension. I will sit on the bench with my team during my suspension. If I do not attended the games during my suspension I understand it will be carried over to the next game.
