Victoria Junior Field Hockey Association Spring League

Registration begins on November 1st, 2016, and is available through the 2017 'LEAGUE REGISTRATION' link on our website at www.victoriajuniorfieldhockey.ca.

On-line Registration System

All registrations and payments are now processed through the system.

Everyone registered in 2016 can use their existing account to register for the 2017 season.

For those registering for the first time, you will need to create a new account as part of the registration process.

Account Access and Registration Process

Access to the on-line registration system is available using the '2017 LEAGUE REGISTRATION' link on our website at [http://www.victoriajuniorfieldhockey.ca/](http://www.victoriajuniorfieldhockey.ca)

Please contact the Administrator (info@victoriajuniorfieldhockey.ca) if you have forgotten your password or have trouble logging on to your existing account.

When you connect to the registration site, you will be presented with a "2017 Registration" page that shows the Divisions and Age Groups, registration period, fees for each Age Group and early registration discounts. At the bottom of the web page is a section to logon to an existing account or create a new account.

Once you have logged on to your account, please choose the **Division** for the player you are registering. Options are:

- Kindies (U6)
- Girls U7 – U11
- Girls U13 – U15
- Boys U8 – U10
- Boys U13 – U15

Entering the player's **Birth Date** in the next step will automatically place your player in their correct **Age Group**:

If a child would like to play in an **Age Group** that does not match their age level, they must receive permission through the Administrator (info@victoriajuniorfieldhockey.ca) after registration, based on the following guidelines:

- A player can only request to move up an **Age Group** if they have scheduling conflicts for their weekday practice times.
- If they have scheduling conflicts with the weekend game sessions, they must apply for special consideration to the VJFHA executive for permission.
- Please enter your Player Information and Other Contacts Information.

Our **Waiver** is online (no more paper copies!), and you must accept it to proceed with registration. The waiver is still available for you to [view on our website](#). Click 'Next' to go to the Financial Information page.

We are pleased to offer a **comprehensive registration and payment process** again this year. Your single registration and payment includes:

- 2017 Victoria Junior Field Hockey Spring League Registration
- Field Hockey BC (FHBC) Registration, Membership Number, and Insurance – we will register your player for this on your behalf
- Registration with Field Hockey Canada for players U13 and older – we will register your player for this on your behalf through FHBC

Note: If your player has already activated their FHBC number for this year, we will provide a rebate for the amount within two weeks of FHBC confirming the registration.

Team Placement

In the final week of February, the Master Coaches and Division Coordinators will draft teams as evenly as possible. During registration, participants may identify **one** player that they would like to play with. If more than one player is entered in this field, only the first player listed will be considered.

Equipment

Players will receive a League t-shirt and mouth guard at their first session. It is **mandatory** that players wear shin guards and mouth guards when they are participating. A player will not be allowed to participate in practices or games without wearing a mouth guard and shin guards.

Turf shoes or running shoes are best – **soccer cleats are not allowed**, as they damage the water-based turf). Players are encouraged to wear black shorts and socks, and are asked to provide their own stick.

Vendors may be on site at the Come Try the Game Free days to sell sticks and other field hockey gear. A list of local suppliers is available on our website.
