Scholarship Application Rules and Regulations

- 1) BC Minor Baseball Association (BCMBA) will offer a minimum of one and a maximum of three scholarships each year.
- 2) Scholarships shall be awarded by BCMBA to any successful applicant who, for the three or more years, has played within an association that is a member of BCMBA and who is currently participating in some capacity in baseball: this may be as a player, umpire, coach or administrator.
- 3) The qualifications of recipients have to be:
 - a. Proceeding from Grade 12 to any accredited university, college or other secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee
 - b. Attending a post-secondary institute, but who are under 19 years of age as of January 1st of the current playing season
 - c. Must have a minimum "B" average
 - d. Must have demonstrated good citizenship, personality and leadership in a non-playing capacity for their association.
- 4) All applicants must follow the scholarship application process outlined in this policy in order to be considered for a BCMBA Scholarship. BCMBA reserves the right to forego

processing any applications from applicants who do not follow the procedure outlined below.

- 5) The funds will be withheld until such time the recipient provides proof of payment of tuition either the first semester or in full as well as proof of enrollment that he/she is attending any post-secondary institution approved by the Scholarship Committee.
- 6) A scholarship that is awarded, but not availed within two (2) years of the award winner's high school graduation year will be deemed to be null and void. The aforementioned scholarship award will be then awarded to a new candidate the following year.

Application Process

- 7) All Scholarship applications must be submitted no later than September 30th of each year.
- 8) All applications must contain three components:
 - a. Submit a completed application form
 - b. Three written references
 - i. A letter of reference from the Principal or Post-Secondary Administrator certifying the candidate's age, character and ability, as well as participation in school activities.
 - ii. A letter of reference from a Local Association League Official, Head Coach or Umpire-in-Chief indicating the candidate's character, leadership examples, participation in community activities, as well as information regarding the candidate's baseball ability, contribution to umpiring, coaching or administrative involvement.
 - iii. A personal letter of reference from family friend, coach or teacher regarding candidate's character.
 - c. Submit a transcript of the student's marks or photocopy of the Permanent Record Card (if neither is available, a typed copy of the Permanent Record Card verified by the Principal's or Secondary Administrator's signature will be accepted).
