This Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Policy describes the West Ferris Minor Hockey Association's (WFMHA) current policies and practices with regard to personal data collected by the WFMHA. The term "personal data" refers to personally identifiable information about you, such as your name, birth date, e-mail address, mailing address, registration and financial information pertaining to you or your children registered with the WFMHA and any other information that is identified with you personally including credit card information and payment history relating to registration with WFMHA.

Notification of Changes to This Policy.

The WFMHA plans to continually improve and add new functionality and features to its Web Site and improving and adding to our existing products, services and programs. Because of these changes, changes in the law, and the changing nature of technology, the WFMHA's data practices will change from time to time. If and when our data practices change, the WFMHA will post the changes on the Web site and may provide other forms of notice to you. We encourage you to check our Web Site frequently.

Personal Data Collected by WFMHA.

The only personal data the WFHA currently collects is information surrounding the registration of WFMHA players, coaches, teams and related financial information. We collect this information through our Web Site and through the information you provided us when you completed and delivered the completed WFMHA player registration form. We may also collect information from you when you use our Web Site to request information or communicate with members of our organization. We may in the future also collect information from you when you register a player using our new online registration program.

Use of Personal Data Collected Through the WFMHA.

The WFMHA uses the information you provide to respond to your e-mails; answer your questions; or resolve your problem, concern or issue. We also use the information you provided to advise necessary notification to coaches, conveners and team managers of the completeness of your registration form, including any balance owed to WFMHA from time to time. The WFMHA uses this information to help us improve the administration of the organization; to improve the content and functionality of our Web Site; and to better understand our members and players.

Anonymous Data Collected Through www.wfmha.ca.

In addition to the information you provide when you use our Web site, the WFMHA may currently or in the future use technology to collect anonymous information about the use of our Web site. For example, we may use technology to track how many visitors access our Web site, the date and time of their visit, the length of their stay, and which pages they view. We also may use technology to determine which Web browsers our visitors use and the address from which they accessed our site. This technology does not identify you personally. It simply enables us to compile statistics about our visitors and their use of our site. The WFMHA uses this anonymous data to improve the content and

functionality of its Web Sites, to better understand our viewing audience, and to improve services we provide to our players and members.

Cookies.

In order to collect the anonymous data described in the preceding paragraph, the WFMHA may use temporary "cookies" that collect the first level domain name of the user (for example, if your e-mail address is "name@abc.com," the cookie collects the "abc.com" portion of your e-mail address) and the date and time you accessed the Web Site. Cookies by themselves cannot be used to discover the identity of the user. A cookie is a small piece of information which is sent to your browser and stored on your computer's hard drive. Cookies do not damage your computer. You can set your browser to notify you when you receive a cookie. This enables you to decide if you want to accept it or not.

Disclosure of Your Personal Data.

The WFMHA will not share any of the personal data collected through this Web site or our data bank, other than in some limited circumstances in which the WFMHA may share or transfer the personal data in our databases, for example, to comply with a legal requirements for the administration of justice, for the orderly administration of our business including confirmation of payment of registration fees and balances; to protect your vital interests, or in the event of a reorganization, dissolution or similar fundamental change in our organization.

Link to Other Sites.

This Privacy Policy applies only to the www.wfmha.ca. The www.wfmha.ca contains hyperlinks to Web sites that are not operated by the WFMHA. These hyperlinks are provided for your reference and convenience only and do not imply any endorsement of the activities of these third-party Web sites or any association with their operators. The WFMHA does not control these Web sites and is not responsible for their data practices. We urge you to review the Privacy Policy posted on any site you visit before using the site or providing any personal data about yourself or your children.
