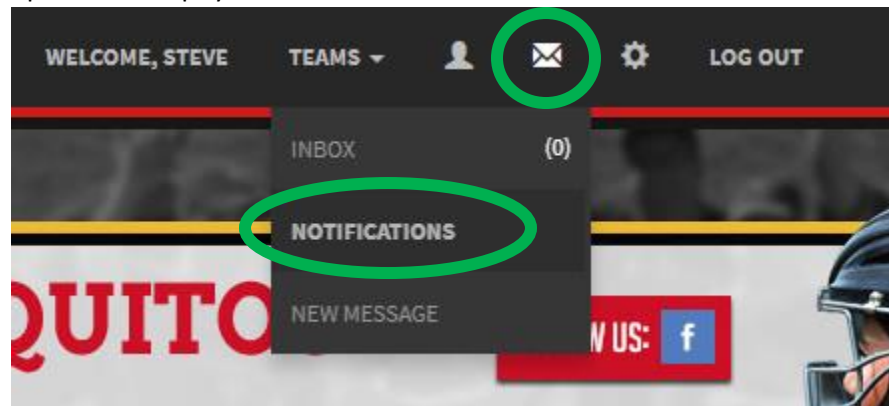
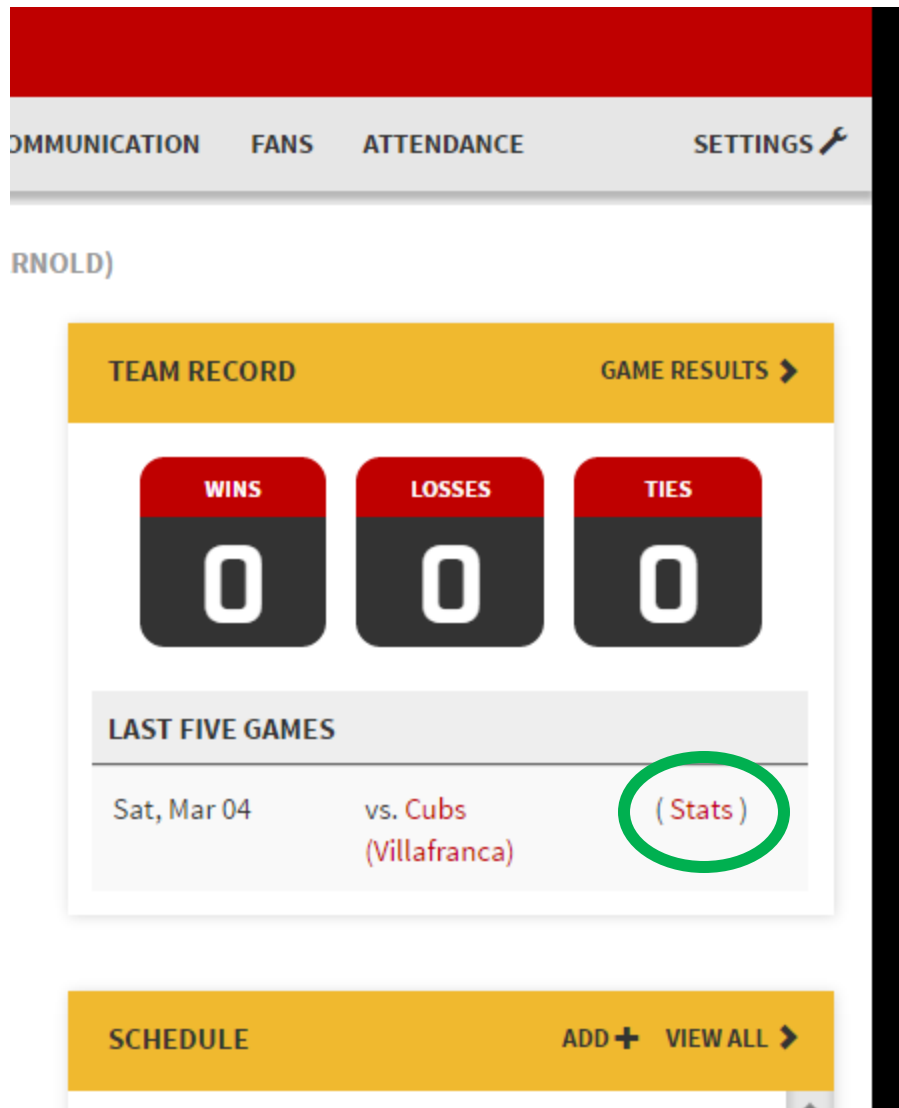


How to post Pitch Counts, Scores, and Homeruns on the RPLL Website (2018)



- 1) Log into your account
- 2) Go to your team page
 - a. If you do not have access to your team, ensure you have accepted your team.
 - i. In order to accept your team, log into the website and click the Envelope Icon in the upper right.
 - ii. Click the NOTIFICATIONS option in the drop-down menu and you will see an option to accept your team.

 - iv. If you do not see the option to accept your team, it is likely your team is registered under a different email address.
 1. Contact the webmaster at steve@rpll.org to confirm the correct email address is being used.
- 3) On the right side of your team page, you should see the Team Record box. Click on the "Stats" link for the game you wish to score and add pitch counts.

- 4) Enter the runs per inning (optional) and/or the final score.
 - a. If the game is a forfeit, do not enter any score – click the DEFAULT check box for the winning team.
 - b. Do NOT click the DEFAULT check box if the game was played as usual.

- 5) Go down to the Positional Player section. For any pitchers used during the game, use the pull-down to select "Pitcher".

Only click Default for forfeits.
