About me: I grew up playing tennis and soccer, and was very involved in ALTA and Junior Tournaments all over the state. I was a Varsity Tennis Letterman for four years at Woodward Academy, and graduated summa cum laude in 1992. I attended the University of Virginia, majoring in biology, minoring in history, and was named an Echols Scholar during freshman year. I attained my medical degree from the Medical College of Georgia, and from there went on to complete a pediatric residency at Vanderbilt Children's Hospital in Nashville, Tennessee. After finishing a Chief Resident year, I pursued a primary care sports medicine fellowship at Vanderbilt Sports Medicine Center. While at Vanderbilt I worked with athletes of all ages, and served as team physician for several local high schools, Belmont University Men's soccer and Men's and Women's basketball, and the Vanderbilt football squad. I am one of only about 100 physicians with residency training in pediatrics to complete a fellowship in sports medicine and hold a Certificate of Added Qualification from the American Board of Pediatrics.
