If registering for the first time you will need a copy of your child's birth certificate or care card to show proof of age, which is mandatory as per BCSSA. The proof of age must be brought to the assessment. Thank-you!

- A club t-shirt to show support for our team! (New families get a t-shirt AND a team Tritons swim cap)
- BCSSA insurance fee of \$56.00
- Becoming a better swimmer by building character and discipline through vigorous training, personal challenges and competition
- Coaching on strokes, turns, starts, training and competition
- Professional coaches possessing or attaining their certification through the National Coaching Certification Program with excellent training programs in place

1. Returning swimmers have **2 weeks** from May 1st, 2019 to request a timely refund in writing from the executive. They will receive a refund less \$56 (\$36 BCSSA fee plus \$20 administration fee) of their total fees paid.
2. New swimmers have **2 weeks** from the date of their first swim to request a timely refund from the executive. They will receive a refund less \$56 (\$36 BCSSA fee plus \$20 administration fee) of their total fees paid.
3. **NO REFUNDS** will be given after the 2-week period unless a valid medical reason is submitted to the Executive and subject to review at the first Executive Meeting in September (a pro-rated rate may be considered).

Swim Club Program Descriptions

Note: Alumni & Master's Registrants pay separately for swim meets.

ALUMNI SWIMMER – Member of Tritons for 3 years and have swam at the Intermediate or Senior Level. Fee includes max 4 training sessions/week. Fee includes entry into the Surrey/Cloverdale Meet & Regionals. **Payment of entry fees up front for each additional meet entered. Cost is \$340.00**

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM - Introduction to competitive swim - Is intended to introduce basic swimmers to competitive swim. Swimmers practice are three times per week typically, M,W,F at 3:30/3:45 for 75 mins. 15 minutes of dryland and 60 mins in the pool.(subject to change) **Fee includes entry into 2 development meets (WRASA & Ladner) and the Surrey/Cloverdale Meet. Cost is \$250. The development program finishes August 2nd 2019.**

Swimming Ability & Assessments

New swimmers to have passed any of the following lesson programs:

- Red Cross Swimming Kids 6
- I Can Swim Stage 2 - Advanced
- YMCA Star 1

If your child has participated in other swimming lessons, the minimum requirements to come for an assessment are 25 meters freestyle (unassisted), 25 meters backstroke (unassisted) and a 50 meters continuous swim. If you are unsure, book an assessment. Sometimes our children surprise us!

MASTERS PROGRAM - Triton Masters Swimming is for those interested in participating in professionally coached swim practices in an outdoor pool in the summer. You are invited to come for a trial practice to meet our coaches and experience the benefits before you fully commit. We welcome students, academics, professionals and retirees, from 18

to 80 years old whose interests range from simply maintaining their health and fitness to racing in triathlon or organized competition at the provincial, national and international level swim competitions.

Interested swimmers must be at least 18 years of age and able to swim at least 100 meters (4 lengths) with basic freestyle technique. Fee includes entry into the Surrey/Cloverdale Meet & Regionals. **Cost is \$230.00 Practice days & times TBA.** Last swim is August 2nd 2019.

FUNDRAISING & PARENT PARTICIPATION FEE: \$400.00

- If you have not accumulated your 20 points, you will be charged (it's easy and fun) \$400.00 through Active Networks on August 16th, 2019.
- Failure to pay will result in not being able to register for any of our programs.

This is our biggest fundraiser of the year. There will be sign-up sheets posted closer to the Swim Meet.
- In addition to your registration costs we will be collecting **\$10 per swimmer (up to a maximum \$20 per family)** to be used towards purchasing deck food for our Officials and Volunteers.

Each family is required to accumulate **20 points** for the summer season. We rely on parent/guardian(s) to help run the club every year. If you have a swimmer who ONLY swims development, you are required to earn **10 points**.

This year we have moved to a points system, outlined below you will see that there are many opportunities to help out the club.

If you have not accumulated your 20 points, you will be charged \$400.00 through Active Networks on August 15th, 2019. Failure to pay will result in not being able to register for any of our programs.

Surrey/Cloverdale Swim Meet

There are many opportunities to volunteer for our joint swim meet – this is an “All Hands-on Deck” meet and requires **mandatory participation of a minimum of 10 hours** over the weekend. Many members will be needed to volunteer beyond these 10 hours as we are excited to be hosting at the Guildford Aquatics Centre this year. **(No points are awarded for the swim meet)**
