



LANGLEY FLIPPERS INVITATIONAL SWIM MEET

June 22 & 23 | 2019 | OFFICIAL MEET PACKAGE



LOCATION:

Al Anderson Memorial Pool, Langley City Park; 4949 – 207 Street, Langley, BC

SCHEDULE:

- Warm-ups: 6:15 – 7:30 A.M. (Lanes will be sent out via email.)
- Scratches & Deck Entries: 7:20 A.M. both days.
- Officials' meeting: 7:30 A.M. both days.
- Coaches' meeting: 7:45 A.M. both days.
- Heats: First marshalling at 8:00 A.M. Events start 8:15 A.M.
- Relays: 10 minutes after prelims
- Finals: Warm Up: 10 minutes after relays.
- Fees paid: 8:30 A.M. Sunday
- Relay lists: 9:30 A.M. both days.

FACILITIES:

- 25 meter – 8 lane outdoor pool; Electronic Timing System.
- "Track-Start" Blocks
- Walking trails, playground and waterpark in grounds.
- Concession on both days – breakfast & lunch.
- Consumption of alcohol is strictly prohibited.
- Park space for club and family tents.
- **PLEASE NOTE:** Both the music school and baseball fields surrounding the pool also have events going on over the same weekend as the swim meet. Please allow extra time for finding parking.

FORMAT:

- BCSSA rules apply.
- Cardless Meet format
- Championship finals (1st – 8th) will be swum.
- This is an open meet; there will be no A/B distinction.
- Relays and Div 0 (6 & Under) will be timed finals.
- At this meet, the working deck includes all of the space behind the starting blocks to the fence, and all space within 1.8 meters of the other 3 edges of the pool. In order to ensure fairness to all swimmers, the working deck will remain off-limits to everyone except swimmers during their events, and officials. Spectators are not permitted inside the working deck area. Swimmers can talk to their coaches, at the coaching tables, and then must exit working deck.
- No parents or guests will be permitted on the pool deck or within the marshalling area. The Warm-Up rules will be in effect and coaches must pre-clear lanes prior to any dive sprints. Safety Marshals will be monitoring lanes and ensuring this rules adhered to.
- Events are officially called by the Clerk of the Course in the marshalling area. It is the responsibility of the swimmers to be close enough to hear the Clerk call the events. Any calls made by the announcer over the P.A. system are courtesy calls only.
- Because serious injuries can occur, all loose fitting jewelry must be removed before events. Wearing of tightly fitting jewelry is done at the swimmer's own risk.
- Meet Manager reserves the right to modify meet format if required.

***RETURNING* FAMILY RELAY:**

- There will be a Family relay (4 x 25 any stroke and no diving in the shallow end) on Saturday following the Medley Relays.
- Any non-BCSSA swim member wishing to participate MUST complete the [Parent Relay Membership Form](#) and submit it Saturday morning to the Meet Manager with the **\$5.00 fee in cash**.
- **Themes and costumes highly recommended!**
- **RULES:** All relay participants must be family members (does not necessarily have to be within immediate family).
- **Relays can consist of combinations of any of the following:**
 1. 4 Family members
 2. 3 Family members + 1 non-related swimmer
 3. 2 Family members from one family + 2 family members from another family
- **ALL RELAY MEMBERS MUST BE ABLE TO SWIM 25M UNASSISTED.**

***NEW* TREASURE TRAWL:**

- At any point throughout the meet, the announcer will play a Pirates of the Caribbean theme song over the PA and announce that the upcoming race is a “treasure trawl”. When that happens, the race swum immediately after that message will provide swimmers an opportunity to win a prize if they win their heat. Prizes will be determined by the Langley Flippers Swim Club and will not be disclosed prior to the meet.

SNAPCHAT FILTER:

- The Langley Flippers will feature a custom Snapchat filter for swimmers and parents to use at the meet. To use the filter, take an image using the “Snapchat” app, and then swipe to the left of the screen until you see our filter. We encourage users to share their Snapchat stories on Instagram using the hashtag #lfscmeet2019.

OFFICIALS:

- All clubs are required to supply a minimum of 2 Stroke and Turn or Senior Deck Officials, throughout the meet. Please sign up on the Officials Board, on the north east fence corner, by 7:30 A.M.
- Clubs will also be assigned lanes for timers and recorders. Two timers and one recorder are required at all times in each lane. Thanks everyone!

FEES:

- Fraser Valley clubs will pay fees according to the Regional Fee Agreement.
- Individual events - \$6.00 per event for swimmers from outside the Fraser Valley region.
- Relay events - \$7.00 per team.
- Deck entries - \$8.00 per deck entry.
- There will be no refunds for late scratches.
- Please make cheques payable to: Langley Flippers Swim Club
- **Submit payment to the Meet Manager, by 8:30 A.M. Sunday morning.**

ENTRIES:

- Meet has a maximum capacity of 600 swimmers.
- Swimmers may enter a maximum of **4** individual events and **2** relay events.
- The top 3 heats will be circle seeded for all preliminary rounds, and the remaining heats will be rank seeded, slowest to fastest. Swimmers entered with no time will be seeded in the slowest heats.
- **Deck entries and scratches** must be submitted to the Clerk of the Course, by 7:20 A.M. on the day of the event. Deck entries will be accepted as space and time permits without re-seeding. The Meet Manager reserves the right to refuse any deck entry.
- "O" swimmers should be entered in their corresponding "O" category events. The Clerk of the Course may, at their discretion, combine "O" swimmers with the "S" swimmers for the heats. They will swim in "O" Cat 1 or 2 for finals.
- The Clerk of the Course may combine events in heats and finals at their discretion.
- Relay teams may include swimmers from lower divisions but **MUST** include one team member from the entered division. One "O" cat swimmer may be included per "S" relay.
- **Relay team lists must be written on the entry card and handed in to the Clerk of Course by 9:30 A.M. each morning.**

Deadline for Hy-tek entries is Tuesday, June 18th, 2019 @ 2:00 pm

Scratches may be emailed up until 9:00 pm Friday, June 21st, 2019
