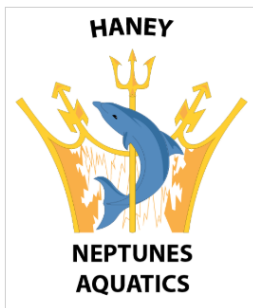
The successful candidate will develop and execute a plan that builds interest in our program so that we are in a position to field teams in the 2020 BCSSA Summer Season. From February – April we are planning on offering practices two hours/week to help build interest and develop players. From May – August the successful candidate will run our summer **ARTISTIC** swimming program.

General Job Description & Expectations:

- Develop and implement a seasonal program and practice schedule for all swimmers
- Conducts team workouts, fundamentals of STAR 1-8 figures, skill development, and routine basics.
- Work collaboratively with the Director of Artistic Swimming, Club President, Head Coach – Swimming and Head Coach
- Maintain professional working relationships with coaching staff, executive, parents and athletes
- Develop a plan to build interest in the Haney Neptunes artistic swimming program
- Be prepared for each practice session by developing workout plans that are appropriate for your assigned group
- Demonstrate strong leadership skills combined with excellent organization and communication skills
- Demonstrate an ability to motivate artistic swimmers of all ages and skill levels
- Foster a team culture that is fun, caring and safe for all
- Attends competitions as designated in the contract
- Acts in accordance with the Coaches Code of Ethics and all Haney Neptunes Policies
- Performs other related duties as assigned by the Executive
