Swim Club Program Descriptions

PREMIUM PROGRAM \$525.00:

- Monday to Friday practices mid-May to mid-August (limited training May 1-12th at SSLC)
- Most practice times are between 3:30 – 6:00, with a few 7:00-8:30pm and mornings 6:00-7:30 (May, June) or 7:00-8:30 in July and August. Morning practices are usually scheduled for older swimmers.
- All Swim meet registration fees included!** - up to 10 weekend meets and 4 development meets from June to August, plus Regionals and Provincials Championships in mid-August for swimmers who qualify
- A club t-shirt to show support for our team! (***New families get a t-shirt AND a team Tritons swim cap***)
- BCSSA insurance fee of \$43.00
- Becoming a better swimmer by building character and discipline through vigorous training, personal challenges and competition
- Coaching on strokes, turns, starts, training and competition
- Professional coaches possessing or attaining their certification through the National Coaching Certification Program with excellent training programs in place
- A fun, challenging, group atmosphere with lots of fun social activities
- Swim meets (rain or shine) **with parent involvement at all levels**

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BASIC PROGRAM: \$350.00

Available to all swimmers new and returning

Includes all of the above Premium membership but **DOES NOT INCLUDE ANY MEET FEES** apart from those listed below.

Fee includes entry into the **Cloverdale Meet & Regionals and Provincials if they qualify ONLY**. **Payment of entry fees for other meets swimmers attend is due at registration for the meet. No exceptions. These fees will be charged through ACTIVE.** Meets entered for 1 day (either Saturday or Sunday) will be \$30.00. The cost for BOTH days (Saturday and Sunday) is \$50.00. The cost for the Crescent Beach B meet is \$30.00.

DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM: \$250.00

The development program begins at Greenaway Pool mid-May and finishes August 6th 2020.

- **Introduction to competitive swim** - Is intended to introduce basic swimmers to competitive swim. Swimmers practice are three times per week typically, M,W,F between 3:30-6:00 for 90 mins. 30 minutes of dryland and 60 mins in the pool.(subject to change) **Fee includes entry into 2 development meets (WRASA & Ladner) and the Cloverdale Meet.**

Swimming Ability & Assessments

If your child has participated in other swimming lessons, the minimum requirements to come for an assessment are 25 meters (unassisted) which is 1 length of the pool. If you are unsure, book an assessment. Sometimes our children surprise us!

O'CAT PROGRAM: \$175.00

Program begins July 1st until the Provincials in August. For O'cat (winter swimmers) ONLY. Includes unlimited practices and fees for the Cloverdale meet July 4-5 as well as Regional and Provincial Championships. All swimmers **MUST be registered by July 9th** to be eligible to swim at Regionals and Provincials. Any other meet will be an additional cost as listed in the basic program. **MUST** swim at least one meet to qualify for Regionals. CANCELLATION/REFUND POLICY:

All refund requests **AFTER the first two weeks** are to be submitted in writing to the Executive and decided upon at the first Executive Meeting in September. Refunds will be administered in September.

1. Returning swimmers have **2 weeks** from May 1st, 2020 to request a timely refund in writing from the executive. They will receive a refund less \$63 (\$43 BCSSA fee plus \$20 administration fee) of their total fees paid.
2. New swimmers have **2 weeks** from the date of their first swim to request a timely refund from the executive. They will receive a refund less \$63 (\$43 BCSSA fee plus \$20 administration fee) of their total fees paid.
3. **NO REFUNDS** will be given after the 2-week period unless a valid medical reason is submitted to the Executive and subject to review at the first Executive Meeting in September (a pro-rated rate may be considered).

- Limited training schedule based on pool availability to follow when available

Swimmers Season starts mid-May @ Greenaway Pool (17901 60th avenue in Cloverdale)

- Full training schedule begins at Greenaway (schedule will be posted on the website)
- Development Program ends August 6th

FUNDRAISING & PARENT PARTICIPATION FEE: \$400.00

- If you have not accumulated your 20 points, (easy and fun to do) you will be charged \$400.00 through Active Networks on August 15th, 2020.
- Failure to pay will result in not being able to register for any of our future programs.

Team Gear (Swimsuits & Caps)

- Team aquatics located in the Watermania Aquatic Centre is a good choice to buy gear (goggles, fins, suits)
- Also, parents find Amazon.ca and swimoutlet.com great for purchasing gear. We will have team aquatics visit the pool in May to outfit the swimmers with what they may still need to purchase. However, we will have an equipment swap within the club before this date.

Payment Options

- We have flexible payment options for Inclusive and Basic registration - you can pay all at once when registering or the \$125.00 registration fee upon registration and with 2 separate payments over the summer. June 1st and July 1st. **Development and O'cat swimmers fees will be collected in FULL upon registration.** Talk to the registrar if you have any questions or concerns about the options.

Fundraising Volunteer Waiver

Each family is required to accumulate **20 points** for the summer season. We rely on parent/guardian(s) to help run the club and fundraise every year. Our fees are kept low do to the hard work from the parents and swimmers throughout the summer. We are a not for profit society and therefore rely on each other.

If you have a swimmer who ONLY swims development, you are required to earn **10 points**. No points are required for the O'cat registration.

This year we have moved to a points system, outlined below you will see that there are many opportunities to help out the club.
