

## NEISD Swimming Aquatics Safety Protocol & Procedures Fall 2020

### Davis Natatorium/Bill Walker Pool

#### High School and Club Divers

- Self-screen for symptoms at home before arriving at Aquatic facilities-see below
- One individual per diving apparatus; 6 feet social distancing (SD) at all times
- Enter Davis facility front door as marked sign in at facility entrance desk
- Enter Davis deck area through “Entrance Doors”, signs will be posted (SD)
- Exit Davis deck area through marked “Exit” doors and exit facility through marked “Exit” doors.
- Showers, lockers are not available (SD), restroom toilets will be accessible
- Bring your own water bottle; water fountains not accessible
- No cell phones allowed in facility
- Follow all safety protocol procedures posted at facility
- No “high fives” or hand shaking before and after an event

Patrons not following all safety procedures and safety protocols will be asked to leave the facility. Any patron, coach, or staff member living with someone who experiences any of the symptoms of Covid-19, whether they have a positive Covid-19 test or not, should isolate for two weeks. If they do not experience any Covid-19 symptoms during that period, they can return to the Sports Park Pool facility. If they experience symptoms, they must self-isolate until the conditions outlined below have been met.

In the case of an individual who was diagnosed with Covid-19, the individual may return to the facility when all three of the following criteria are met:

1. At least three days (72 hours) have passed since recovery(resolution of fever without the use of fever-reducing medications)
2. The individual has improvement in symptoms (e.g., cough, shortness of breath)
3. At least ten days have passed since the symptoms first appeared

In the case of an individual who has symptoms that could be Covid-19 and does not get evaluated by a medical professional or tested for Covid-19, the individual is considered to have Covid-19, and the individual may not return to the facility until the individuals has completed the three-step criteria above.

If the individual has symptoms that could be Covid-19 and wants to return to the facility before completing the self-isolation period, the individual MUST obtain a medical professional’s note clearing the individual for return based on an alternative diagnosis.

#### Covid-19 Symptoms for Screening

Cough	Shortness of Breath	Chills	Repeated shaking with chills
Muscle Pain	Headache	Sore Throat	Loss of taste or smell
Diarrhea	Feverish/100.00 degree temperature or greater
