



2020 Return to Play



Sudbury Minor Hockey Association & Copper Cliff Minor Hockey Association

We thank everyone for registering in hopes to get everyone back on the ice and back to the game they love to play. As you were made aware, Copper Cliff and Sudbury Minor Hockey Association are going to be working together to provide an opportunity for players to get back on the ice until we can eventually get back to full hockey.

We want to ensure all of our members that we are working hard to get hockey started as early as possible. We understand that it may be frustrating since things seem to be changing quickly and it is very hard to get information out in a timely manner. We had hoped to start the new season on Labour Day, as usual, but have now decided to start on Saturday September 12, 2020.

We felt that since school is returning from a long layoff, it would be in the best interests of all of the players to get back and to be comfortable in returning to school.

Please note that you should have received an email confirmation of registration. If you don't have that email and believe that you registered your child/children to play, please log in and complete the 'checkout' process. Select 'other' when you get to the payment option. If this process isn't fully completed the player will not be on the registration list to be placed in a 'bubble'.

See below what our return to play will look like.

September 12, 2020 – Start to Rep Hockey (If you played Rep hockey last season, you will be placed in a Rep 'bubble' this season. If you played Rep but now wish to play in a HL 'bubble', please email your association with your wishes ASAP).

- Rep hockey will include U18/U15/U13/U11
- League bubbles will consist of a maximum of 50 players
- Players of similar skill set will be assigned to teams within each bubble
- Duration (September 12, 2020 – October 2, 2020)
- Teams will receive **minimum** of 10 hours of ice time within the above time period
 - o Ice times maybe be 60 or 90 minutes
 - o 1-3 Ice times per week
 - o Number of players on the ice will consist of 10 – 30 players/coaches
- All ice will be at Countryside #1 (for September 12-October 2)
- Parents and or Guardians will be contacted by coaches by Labour Day via email/phone call to provide details such as schedule and other information to return to play.
- If you decide **NOT** to continue with the registration, please email the association that you registered with and confirm withdraw.

Cost

- There is a one-time insurance fee for your Hockey Canada card **(\$62.00)**
- There is a one-time fee from the NOHA for rostering each card **(\$5.00)**
 - o This will be paid once for the entire 2020-2021 season, regardless of how the season structure is determined
- Fee for Rep Hockey will be **\$150.00 (September 12, 2020 – October 2, 2020)**
- **Total Payment Due - \$217.00**
- Payments will be required prior to September 12th. Due to COVID-19, we will only be accepting E-Transfers and ask that you pay the association that you registered with.

October 3, 2020 – Start of remaining Rep Hockey, HL Hockey and U7

- U7 (former Initiation Program)
- U9 (former Novice)
- U18/U15/U13/U11 – HL
- League bubbles will consist of a maximum of 50 players
- Players of similar skill set will be assigned to teams within each bubble
- Duration October 3, 2020- October 30, 2020
- Cost and structure will be determined on number of registered players as well as ice availability from the city

Once the teams are assigned within each bubble, coaches will contact you to provide you will the schedule for September and any other information required.
