



TIMMINS ARENA COVID GUIDELINES – RETURN TO ICE

McINTYRE ARENA

****Please note that all ice rentals are subject to change/cancellation depending on the status of COVID 19 and any provincial regulations that may be put in place.**

General Information – Maximum of 25 skaters on the ice

- All individuals must maintain physical distancing and **wear masks** when not on the ice pad. If a patron arrives without a mask entry into the facility will be revoked.
- Scrimmages or games will be permitted as well as skills and drills but prolonged contact among players is not allowed.
- No dryland training will be permitted within the facility.
- All players must arrive dressed. No dressing rooms will be provided.
- **Upon completion of your rental time, players will return to their chairs, take their helmets, gloves, and skates off and put their shoes on. They will not undress/change to street clothes at that time. This will be done off site. The only exception is goalies who are allowed to quickly remove their gear. You have 10 minutes to leave the premises. Everyone must follow the designated signs, and arrows in regards to where to enter and where to exit the building.**
- The water fill stations will be shut off so you must bring your own pre-filled water bottle.
- The restrooms off of the main lobby will be available for use if required.
- **Spectators are not welcome at this time.**
- All patrons entering the facility must wear a mask at all times as per Public Health Regulations.
- All patrons must listen to instructions of the arena staff at all times.

Procedure to Be Followed

- Your group will have access to the building 10 minutes before your rental start time. Skaters, instructors, coaches and officials must enter through the side door off the south parking lot.
- Chairs will be provided in the Main Lobby for skaters to put their skates on and staff will be available to assist with traffic flow and designated seating areas.
- Chairs will also be provided in the south side tunnel near change rooms 4 & 5, for skaters to put their skates on and staff will be available to assist with traffic flow and designated seating areas.
- All patrons must listen to instructions of the arena staff at all times.
- When the rental begins, the doors will be re-locked to ensure limited numbers are maintained.
- Access to the penalty box is not permitted. However, use of the players' benches is allowed if required.
- During Floods, participants waiting to enter the ice should not congregate at the rink entrance door/s. We ask that participants maintain physical distancing and wait in their designated chair.
- Upon completion of the ice time, players will leave the ice pad using the labelled exit off the lobby area (usually the same door you entered the ice surface).
- **You must vacate the facility immediately after your rental time is finished (within 10 minutes).** Skaters will change from skates back to street shoes in the same chairs they used previously and exit the building through the door indicated. **If your group changed in the Lobby Area, you will exit through main arena doors in the lobby. If your group changed in the South Tunnel, you will exit through the far east door at the end of tunnel. (south side parking lot) Follow arrows on floor at all times.**
- Once skaters, and instructors have left, sanitization of the areas used will commence prior to the next rental's arrival.
- Please pay attention to the signage that has been posted to help direct you.
- To ensure our facilities can remain open and safe, please obey all rules as presented and obey the instructions of Arena Staff.
- Zero tolerance! Failure to follow guidelines and policies could result in immediate ejection from the facility and future booking privileges revoked.

WHITNEY ARENA

General Information – Maximum of 25 skaters on the ice

- All individuals must maintain physical distancing and **wear masks** when not on the ice pad. If a patron arrives without a mask entry into the facility will be revoked.
- Scrimmages or games will be permitted as well as skills and drills but prolonged contact among players is not allowed.
- No dryland training will be permitted within the facility.
- All players must arrive dressed. No dressing rooms will be provided.
- **Upon completion of your rental time, players will return to their chairs, take their helmets, gloves, and skates off and put their shoes on. They will not undress/change to street clothes at that time. This will be done off site. The only exception is goalies who are allowed to quickly remove their gear. You have 10 minutes to leave the premises.**
- The water fill stations will be shut off so you must bring your own pre-filled water bottle.
- The restrooms off of the main lobby will be available for use if required.
- **Spectators are not welcome at this time**
- All patrons entering the facility must wear a mask at all times as per Public Health Regulations.

Procedure to Be Followed

- Your group will have access to the building 10 minutes before your rental start time. Skaters, instructors, coaches and officials must enter through the front doors on the right side.
- Chairs will be provided in the Main Lobby for skaters to put their skates on and staff will be available to assist with traffic flow and designated seating areas.
- Chairs will also be provided in the hallway outside of the change rooms for skaters to put their skates on and staff will be available to assist with traffic flow and designated seating areas.
- Please listen to the instructions of the Arena Staff at all times.
- When the rental begins, the doors will be re-locked to ensure limited numbers are maintained.
- Access to the penalty box is not permitted. However, use of the players' benches is allowed if required.
- During Floods, participants waiting to enter the ice should not congregate at the rink entrance door/s. We ask that participants maintain physical distancing and wait in their designated chair.
- Upon completion of the ice time, players will leave the ice pad using the labelled exit, which will become the front right side entrance/exit door.
- **You must vacate the facility immediately after your rental time is finished (within 10 minutes).** Skaters will change from skates back to street shoes in the same chairs they used previously and exit the building through the door indicated for your seating area or staff directed.
- Once skaters, and instructors have left, sanitization of the areas used will commence prior to the next rental's arrival.
- Please pay attention to the signage that has been posted to help direct you.
- To ensure our facilities can remain open and safe, please obey all rules as presented and listen to the instructions of the Arena Staff at all times
- Zero tolerance! Failure to follow guidelines and policies could result in immediate ejection from the facility and future booking privileges revoked.
