

COVID Procedures WDMHA Oct 10,2020:

U13-U15-U18

- If your player is exhibiting any signs or symptoms of illness, please keep them home.
- All players **must arrive dressed with the exception of skates, gloves and helmets** and ready to enter the building 15 minutes prior to their icetime. You need to use the Main arena doors under the Winfield Arena sign (East side of the building)
- All players may be accompanied by one adult (including coaches and volunteers) One adult per player.
- Upon entering the building players will turn to the right and head down the hallway to the Players COVID screening person, there will be socially distance markers (white dots) for them to line up on. Once screened they can proceed to the dressing rooms and get their skates on. There is no food or drink allowed in the dressing rooms except for water bottles.
- Spectators will enter the building and proceed directly forward to the Spectator screening area to be screened by the COVID Ambassador and then go directly to marked spots in the viewing area. At the end of practice all spectators are to directly exit through the vending machine doors.
- The dressing rooms have marked seating spots which have been pre-measured for safety. At all times the players are to remain six feet apart.
- If your player needs to use the washroom, they are to go directly to the change room and back onto the ice.
- There is no access to shower facilities.
- At the end of the practice, players will return to the dressing rooms, remove their gear quickly and exit through the vending machine doors.
- We have no more than 15 minutes to clear the building for cleaning and to let the next group in so please bear this in mind.

COVID PROCEDURES WDMHA Oct 3,2020

U7-U9-U11

- If your player is exhibiting any signs or symptoms of illness, please keep them home.
- All players **must arrive dressed with the exception of skates, gloves and helmets** and ready to enter the building 15 minutes prior to their icetime. You must use the Main arena doors under the Winfield arena sign (East side of the building)
- Junior Division players (U7 formerly Initiation,U9 formerly Novice) will be accompanied by one adult (including coaches and volunteers) One adult per player.
- Upon entering the building please turn to the right and head down the hallway to the Players COVID screening person, there will be socially distance markers (white squares) for you to line up on with your child. Please read the signs in the posted in the hallway to expedite the screening process. Screeners will process the player and adult accompanying them.
- One adult per child will be allowed in the dressing room to help get their skates, gloves and helmet on. They still need to arrive dressed.
- The **adults must be wearing masks**, leave the dressing room as soon as your kids are ready and head directly to the stands to watch the practice.
Players will wait in the dressing room for their coaches who will escort them out to the ice.
- The dressing rooms have marked seating spots which have been pre-measured for safety. At all times the players are to remain six feet apart. Once the coaches are ready, they will assist the kids onto the ice surface.
- If your player needs to use the washroom, they will be escorted by the Coach to the ice door nearest the Spectators and you can take your child to the washroom and deliver them back to the ice.
- At the end of the practice, players will return to the dressing rooms, the volunteers will assist them in removing their skates and then they will wait in their dressing room spots for their adults.
- We have no more than 15 minutes to clear the building for cleaning and to let the next group in so please bear this in mind.
