Location

The Fairmont is hosting the SWAP in the MacDonald A & B Ballroom. See map below showing directions to the back lot off of Spearhead Drive, and access will be via the back ramp. Parking will not be available in the overflow lot, please park in the day lots. Follow directional signage to ensure physical distancing is maintained.



General guidelines - COVID-19

- ⇒ In order to comply with Vancouver Coastal Health recommendations and to allow adequate room for physical distancing no more than 50 people at a time may be present at the SWAP (including volunteers and staff).
- ⇒ Any customer, staff, or volunteers who is ill for any reason, or who is exhibiting any symptoms such as fever, cough, runny nose or sore throat, or who may have been exposed to someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 is asked NOT to attend the SWAP sale.
- ⇒ Please Register at [2020 WMSC Ski SWAP](#) and attend only during your registered time slot. If you cannot attend during this time, please email [Christine Cogger](#) to coordinate an alternative.
- ⇒ Please only 1 parent and athlete(s) who are shopping for equipment can attend. We ask that non shopping family or friends do not enter with you. Due to gathering size restrictions, no exceptions can be made.
- ⇒ The use of **face masks** that cover nose and mouth **are mandatory** for anyone entering the SWAP sale. For the health and safety of other customers, staff and volunteers, absolutely **NO** exceptions will be made.
- ⇒ Please follow directional instructions and ensure that you are always maintaining proper physical distancing.
- ⇒ Hand sanitizer will be provided throughout the sale floor and its use is encouraged before and after handling any items.
- ⇒ Please follow volunteer directives when trying on boots and helmets. Please do not try on clothing or soft goods.
- ⇒ Lines for checkout and entrance will have markings to provide adequate physical distancing
- ⇒ **All sales are final! No refunds and no returns.**
- ⇒ Cleaning and sanitization process will be carried out every hour between time slots.

Product drop off guidelines

- ⇒ Please register at [2020 Ski SWAP Check In](#) to drop off your items for sale at the back entrance of the Fairmont (see map above). Do not enter through main hotel doors. There is a 5-minute drop-off zone, please do not park in the outer lot. If you need more time, please park on Blackcomb Way or the day lots. **Ensure that your sellers form is completed with description and price.** We charge a commission per sold item of 30% for Hard goods and 15% for Soft goods

- ⇒ Please note that a maximum of 50 people may be in the ballroom at any one time. We thank you for your patience, should you need to wait in line.
- ⇒ A Fairmont attendant will take your temperature, and you will be required to leave a name and number for contact tracing.

FAQ

What kind of items might I find at the SWAP sale?

New and used ski equipment, accessories, winter apparel and outerwear for adults and children at bargain discount prices.

Examples: Race Skis : SL, GS, SG and DH, FIS approved, WMSC apparel, gloves, poles and more

How do I know if my items sold?

We will be tracking the sales throughout the day and you must pick up unsold items. If all or any of your items are sold we will e-transfer you the sale price less the commission.

Who benefits from the proceeds of the WMSC Ski Swap?

The WMSC Ski SWAP is one of our largest fundraiser events for WMSC and all funds will go the Club. We thank you for your patronage!

What payment methods do you accept?

We prefer credit cards. We will accept cash but will **NOT** accept checks

Does consigned equipment have to meet any standards?

Yes, very old equipment will not sell and we not be accepted. Also, soft goods priced under \$20 will not be accepted. Please note that we cannot accept toques or buffs this year.

Do I need anything to pick up my items that have not sold?

Yes, your sellers form and a photo ID are required for pick up.

What happens if I am unable to pick up my items on Saturday evening?

Please arrange with a friend or family member and provide them with the sellers form. All items left after Saturday, October 10 at 6:00 pm will be donated to charity.
