Registration deadline is January 1, 2021

Payment

- Pay with your debit or credit card directly on the ProCare registration system. Transaction fee will apply.
- Pay by check: Please place your check or money order in your child's school folder. Please notify the teacher that you have a payment in the folder that needs to be turned in for extracurricular activities.
- Extracurricular program payments are due every Friday for the upcoming week. Parents are responsible for the entire amount of each program. If Lake Mary Preparatory School can not physically open its doors due to health and safety reasons, parents will not be responsible for the unattended week. However, if you choose to have your child miss a class or if your child is absent, you are still responsible for the fees.

Signing In & Out

Students who are enrolled in Community School and/or Intramural Sports will be dismissed directly to Kid Power on their scheduled activity day. Kid Power is complimentary until the class begins. The instructor will pick up your child from Kid Power and escort them to their designated area for their afterschool class.

Once the class is over, please meet your child at the Lower School front lobby doors for pick up. Waiting outside, parents/caregivers will be able to sign out their child through the ProCare system. Any student who does not get picked up after their class is over will be sent back to Kid Power and the daily aftercare rate of \$25 will be applied to the child's account.

Keep it Safe!

All teachers, coaches, and instructors will follow Lake Mary Preparatory School's guidelines regarding social distancing and health policies and procedures. Students are required to wear face masks for any indoor extracurricular program. Students who participate in any outdoor extracurricular program must wear their face masks until they can safely distance outside. Students will use hand sanitizer and/or hand wash before and after each class begins.

Please be aware that students who participate in Community School and/or Intramural Sports will be exposed to groups of students at various grade levels.
