As everyone is aware, the Provincial Government has put our area into a grey zone which results in losing our last week of hockey in December as well as the first week of hockey into the new year. Due to the provincial shut down and loss of ice, CCMHA and SMHA have decided to adjust the fees for the second half. *** Extra fees will be determined if teams are approved to play in the NOHLAAA or the GNU18 League. This would be for U13 Major, U15 Major, U16 Minor, U18 Major.

New in 2021

5v5 Games Approved - The OHF has approved the NOHA to move into the next phase of our return to play. The game format will be the same, but games will be played 5v5 instead of the current 3v3, 4v4 format.

Ice Time – Ice time will be like the previous phase, but we hope to schedule more games in the coming months.

GNU18 League (Formally GNML) – U18/U16 Teams will continue to participate in the structure provided and approved from the NOHA and OHF. Information will be provided to the teams when available.

NOHLAAA – The league has asked approval from the OHF to be allowed to run a similar structure as the GNU18 League. If approved SMHA/CCMHA will field a Major Team in U13 & U15. More information will be provided when available.
