

## 2021 Gillette Post 42 Legion Baseball Fees

Gillette Post 42 American Legion Baseball is a non-profit organization which depends a great deal year in and year out upon our players raising monetary donations in our community. There is also a player registration fee that we ask each player to pay. Year in and year out we compare our fees across the region with other elite programs that travel like we do. We continue to be extremely low in our overall player costs, especially with what is asked for out of our players pockets. Our fees this year went up slightly for the first time in 6 years. We are still one of the only programs left that continues to pay for all their players meals on every road trip. We also provide transportation to all away games for all our teams and motel rooms for all road trips. The program depends upon these monies to provide the best possible experience each summer to our players.

Our program continues to put our money back into our players, as is seen by our facilities, buses, tournament schedules, etc. In the fall of 2020, we put over 20 tons of Turface infield dirt on our new outdoor MLB sized practice field. We are also adding another outdoor cage and are excited about the space and opportunities that this practice field will provide for our players and practices. Last but certainly not least, our program has been chosen as the host for the 2021 and 2022 NW Regional Baseball Tournament. This is an event that very few communities get the chance of ever hosting or their players playing in.
