

Registration Instructions for New Players to MVLL

All New Players to MVLL must submit documents showing date of birth and a Mountain View residential address (if not a resident of Mountain View, then registration at a Mountain View school is required).

We have no walk-in registration events at this time due to Covid-19.

These are examples of acceptable documents:

- Player's birth certificate or other government issued proof of birth date
- Utility bill to verify player resides in Mountain View, OR
 - school issued enrollment record at a Mountain View school, or
 - report card from a Mountain View school.

For 2021, we encourage New Players to register online.

Use the online form at our info website, mvll.info. To submit documents for date of birth, residential address in Mountain View, or enrollment at a Mountain View school, please take pictures using your cellphone then send photos to 650-918-6855 or email photos to documents@mvll.org.

If registration must be done in person, please schedule a registration time with Helming's Auto Repair (located near Costco). (Face covering is required.) Bring the completed registration form and documents. The fillable PDF registration form is [here](#). See the note below about compatible apps.

Download the form from our website.

- Print hardcopy and fill-in by hand, or
- Fill-in if using a computer or device then print a hardcopy. Note - **Adobe Acrobat** apps and add-ons will work correctly. Many browser plug-ins (if not from Adobe) will not work correctly.

Deliver the completed form to your team manager during the first week of practice. Team managers need to have the form in their possession in the event of an emergency.

We recommend you retain a copy for your files as the medical release form must be provided at future registrations.
