Coaches:

Players:

- Support fellow teammates and coaches.

Parents:

- No conversations with the coaches until the day following the game. Parent meetings will be scheduled through Lone Peak Athletic Director, Braden Walker.
- Parents will not approach the officials after the game. If you're concerned you can share this with an administrator.
- Negative or demeaning jeers focused on an individual (i.e. coach, official, other parent, or player) may result in parent dismissal from the game.
- We want to continue to have fans attend the games and don't want to have a reason to put the rest of the season in jeopardy.
