Implementation of Curling I/O registration system which parallels to Curl BC and Canada Curling is complete. Thanks to curler Mark Leusink for his input and testing over the summer.

With the exception of Cloverdale and Royal City, all Lower Mainland clubs are now using the I/O system, which has come a long way since first introduced. If you have used it at another club in previous seasons, you are already recognized by the system. Be sure to sign up at an I/O operated club first so you will be charged your affiliation fees once.
